**SCRIP USE FOR FUND-RAISING
BP 1321.1**

DISTRICT SCRIP

It is the policy of the El Dorado Union High School District to assist student athletes in fund-raising efforts by administering a program whereby the student athletes can use Scrip for fund-raising.

No student shall be required to raise a specified amount of money to participate in an activity sponsored by a school-related organization.

(cf. BP/AR 1321 - Solicitation of Funds from and by students)
(cf. BP 3452 - Student Activity Funds)

Student organizations, as defined in El Dorado Union High School District *Administrative Regulations 6124 and 5137*, are authorized to earn Scrip from participating merchants for fund-raising purposes.

With the advance written approval of the principal, a parent organization whose by-laws state its purpose is to support the school, may participate in Scrip fund-raising so long as the District's administrative regulations are followed. Such parent organizations wishing to participate in the Scrip Program shall deal directly with the Scrip vendors.

The Superintendent/designee shall establish regulations to implement this policy.
