

**EL DORADO UNION HIGH SCHOOL DISTRICT  
BOARD POLICY**

**Students**

**ADMISSION  
BP 5111**

The Governing Board believes that all children should have the opportunity to receive educational services, by beginning their high school experience at a district comprehensive high school or district charter school.

The Superintendent or designee shall admit to the 9th grade those students who have graduated from 8th grade or who are recommended for promotion by their 8th grade teacher. The elementary school must verify that the student has shown satisfactory evidence of fitness for high school work.

Students who have not met promotion requirements from 8th grade may be considered for high school enrollment on a case-by-case basis.

The district will accept students transferring from another public or accredited high school. Others may be requested to demonstrate fitness for high school.

Unless otherwise provided for in law, a student shall not be enrolled for less than the minimum school day. *(Education Codes 48200 Compulsory Attendance Law and 46141-47 Minimum School Day)*

The district will accept students transferring from private schools or private tutoring upon providing school records as required by law. These students may also be required to demonstrate subject matter mastery prior to placement in classes.

Principals have the authority and responsibility of evaluating and interpreting transcripts.

The admission/registration process shall identify students with special needs such as learning disabilities, physical handicaps and English language limitations, in order to expedite programming and special services.

The Superintendent or designee shall maintain procedures which provide for the verification of all entrance requirements specified in law and Board policy.
