**INTERNET SAFETY POLICY
BP 6163.4.1**

The Governing Board recognizes that the Internet is a powerful resource that can aid and enhance student learning. The Board encourages the appropriate use of the Internet in order to improve student learning.

The Board is also aware that the Internet and World Wide Web contain materials that may be inappropriate and/or harmful to minors. To protect students from such materials and content, the district will employ and enforce technology protection measures that include specific technologies to block, filter, restrict, or otherwise limit access to inappropriate Internet sites and/or the inappropriate use of technology resources.

Protection measures will be employed to protect students from access to inappropriate content and materials , and to protect students while using on-line services. Protection measures will address the following:

- Pornographic or obscene visual depictions
- Child pornography
- Safety and security while using electronic mail, chat rooms, and other forms of direct electronic communications
- Unauthorized disclosure, use, or dissemination of personal information regarding students or staff
- Unauthorized access, including “hacking,” and other unlawful activities on-line
- Content with specific criminal intent
- Other content and materials deemed in appropriate or harmful to minors.
