High School Registration 2011

The El Dorado Union High School District has released the following student registration information for the 2011–12 school year. School will start on **August 8, 2011**. Consult your respective school's website for the starting times of your school.

EL DORADO & VISTA HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS

The Counseling Office will be closed for summer break from June 20 to July 8, reopening on July 11. Counseling Office hours will be from 7:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. (closed during lunch hour from 12:00 to 1:00 p.m.). Counselors, however, will not be available until July 26.

New students may make an appointment with the Registrar by contacting the Counseling Office at ext. 1029 or 1028, or by emailing Registrar Carol Pesce at cpesce@eduhsd.net. Please note that walk-in registration will not be accepted. Appointments without a Counselor are available from July 19 through July 26. Registration forms are available on-line on the school's web site below, in the Counseling Office, or can be mailed upon request. Counselors will be available by appointment from July 27 through August 5. Students may call ahead (ext. 1028 or 1029) for an appointment time. New students will receive their class schedule at Orientation to be held on August 4 from 5:00 to 8:00 p.m. in the Large Gym. Parent Orientation will start at 6:15 p.m.

Returning students may pick up their schedule on Monday, August 1, between 8:00 a.m. and 12:00 p.m., in front of the school's main office in exchange for a completed Emergency Card and proof of Tdap immunization. Students who do not pick up their schedule on August 1 can turn in their completed Emergency Card and pick up their schedule on the first day of school (August 8), between 7:30 and 8:25 a.m. in front of the Large Gym.

All students must follow the class schedule they receive on the first day of school. Schedule changes will not be made unless the change involves a course required for graduation. Requests for elective changes will not be accepted.

OAK RIDGE HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS

The Counseling Office will be closed for summer break from June 27 through July 15, reopening July 18 from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Counselors will be available after August 3.
